UPCOMING CLASSES

 January 14th-April 1st: Drawing for Beginners
Learn about the materials, substrates, and methods of drawing.
Drawing for beginners will teach you to record what you see onto paper with a variety of mediums. You CAN



draw. All drawing materials provided. This class will be split into four monthly sessions.

January 15th-April 2nd: The Art of Conversation

January 16th: Wet-Felted Mittens

Wet-felting is a textile art form that involves using water, soap and agitation to compact and interlock wool fibers into fabric. In




this class we will wet-felt a pair of mittens to fit your hands, using wool in a selection of colors.
